A large street light would be excellent at the N. Main & Lake Meadow entrance to Wind Meadows.
A little more lighting on side roads would be great.
Again, I haven't seen the Johnson security truck around.
All of these scores are lower than 3 years ago.
Can not walk at night on Lighthouse Drive - no sidewalks.
Car traffic on the Loop (4 Mile, Lighthouse Drive & 3 Mile Roads)
Concerned that we are very close to high crime neighborhoods.
Could use some more lights along 4 Mile Road
Do not desire more lighting - should be less.
Do not like cluster mail box system in Wind Meadows
Excess speed during day: Bldg contractors, vans, school buses, residents, lawn services. Underage drinking & driving - summer & grad parties.
Great police department
Had bike stolen out of garage, when open, think it was kids?
Have experienced two incidents of theft from our cars in driveway in past 30 years.
I approve of the night police patrol.
I came because I wanted to live in the country. Lighting - for each neighborhood - up to residents and they should pay for it. If they want to live in Racine, then move. It's only a few blocks away.
I don't walk at night.
I like the idea of a street light on corner of 4 Mile & Hunt Club.
I love the Village!
I oppose more street lighting (light pollution). I feel safe walking anywhere, anytime - because I have 2 large dogs with me.
I think neighbors are vigilant & caring.
I used to feel safe at night, but anywhere one lives can be a problem in Racine.
I would not feel safe walking alone after dark.
It's perfect just the way it is!
Johnson security helps! We have a false sense of security.
Jonsue Lane could really use a small discreet street light - very dangerous!
Keep it this way
Knock wood!
Last raising of taxes makes it hard to stay here.
Lighted corners would be helpful on loop - no lights
Lighting is perfect. More would destroy charm of area, concern about increase in crime.
Lighting side roads - More lights might help people find their destination.
Like rural atmosphere of few lights.
Lots of teens at Wind Pont Elementary at night. During nice weather, close off hoop area after school or take down hoops PLEASE!!!
Low level lighting to illuminate street corners.
More street lights would be good.
More worried about kids walking at night.
Need bike lanes!
Need lights at Main Roads - 4 Mile & Wind Point Road, 4 Mile & Hunt Club Road
Need more police protection
Need street lights
Never, ever put more street lighting in the Village.
No more street lights!

No place is totally safe. We've had vandalism (kids of area residents). Parents everywhere need to always know where their kids are!
No sidewalks are a concern
Our house was broken into Sept 6 at 9:00 am on a weekday when we were out of town, Subsequently, police have been watchful when we alert them to our being gone.
Personal safety decreased as evidence of being held up in my house at gun point 1.5 years ago.
Police coverage is spotty
Police were unable to solve incidences of vandalism in the past.
Pollution from burning is a health risk.
Prefer side streets remain unlit in future
Public lighting is a big problem for safety.
Public safety presence also helps - i.e. when a patrol car parks on Lake Meadow & Main.
Put a real light bulb in the Lighthouse
Sidewalks or walking paths on Lighthouse Drive would help a lot
Signage on Lighthouse Drive & Wind Meadows cars - SLOW DOWN! Children, walkers & bikers.
Some decline in feeling of safety in past year.
Some street lighting at intersections of side roads would be helpful
Street lighting at 4 Mile Road & Wind Point Road extremely necessary.
